- Slides should explain the 5 elements of a story

 - o Theme
 - Conflict

 - 1. Did you like the movie? Why/not?
 - 2. How "believable" is the plot of the movie? How does that affect the story?
 - 3. Was the movie entertaining? Why/not?
 - 4. What makes a movie "good" for a viewer?
 - 5. What areas in the storyline were lacking? What could have been better? Where did the storyline fall short?
 - 6. What were the strongest and weakest components—plot, character, setting, conflict, theme—of your story?
 - 7. Identify the setting
 - 8. Identify the characters
 - Main character
 - Protagonist
 - Antagonist
 - 9. Identify the:
 - o Setting
 - Conflict
 - 10. Identify the:
 - Plot
 - o Theme
- At least 2 slides should include a numbered list.
- > One slide should have a picture as the background of the slide

Modify your font

- Your text should have at least 3 different font types.
- > You should **change the font color** (2 colors other than black) of some of your text.
- ✓ Include Text Effects/WordArt as your title for the Title Slide
- ✓ Include a **Sound** on one slide
- ✓ Insert at least 1 Clip Art/Picture per slide to match the topic of the presentation.
- ✓ Use the Picture Tools to change the format of each of the ClipArt/Pictures you insert.
- ✓ Insert Text Animations on 6 text or graphical elements in your slides

- ✓ Insert **Slide Transitions** between all slides; do not use more than five different types of slide transitions in the entire presentation.

- ✓ Apply a theme
 ✓ Add a shape to 3 slides. (Make sure it's relevant)
 ✓ Use Shape fill, Shape outline, and Shape Effects on at least 3 slides.
