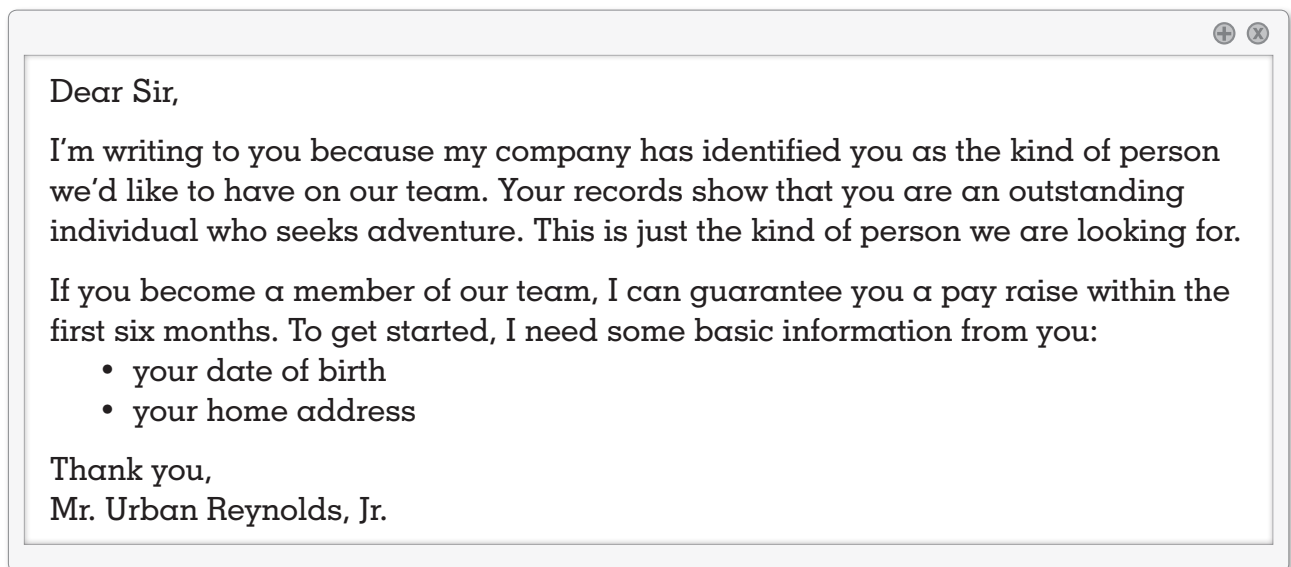


Scams and Schemes
